

Business End User WEEE Take Back scheme

As required under 'The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (Amendment) Regulations 2015' Sulzer Mixpac (UK) Ltd. provides a free of charge WEEE collection service in the United Kingdom (UK) for qualifying WEEE.

Battery powered dispensers are considered WEEE under the legislation.

Qualification under this scheme

1. WEEE from users other than private households arising from product placed on the market **in the UK on or after 13 August 2005** by PC Cox Ltd, Sulzer Mixpac (UK) Ltd or its authorised representatives; and
2. WEEE from users other than private households arising from product placed on the market **in the UK before 13 August 2005** by PC Cox Ltd or its authorised representatives, where Sulzer Mixpac (UK) Ltd or its authorised representatives are supplying new product that is either:
 - a. intended to replace the relevant WEEE product, and
 - b. is of an equivalent type or is fulfilling the same function as the relevant WEEE

To apply for WEEE collections contact your normal Sales representative with full details of the products to be collected.

Notes

All dispenser serial numbers must be provided in advance

Only dispensers complying with the scheme qualification rules will be collected

All dispensers must be packed ready for collection in an agreed manner

If the carrier is unable to collect the goods as arranged upon arrival, charges will apply for additional collection attempts
